Local Volunteer Gives More than Car Rides

Bob Gudorf inherited his work ethic and desire to give back from his father, Norbert.

"I'm a workaholic, and my father was too," he shared with a chuckle. In their hometown of Minster, OH, Norbert was instrumental in building a pool at the high school, a bowling alley, and other projects to benefit the community at large.

He ran an appliance and TV store in the small town in west central Ohio. Bob recalled how every year his father would hold a drawing to give away a brand new bike.

"I never had a new bike, so you bet I was putting my name in the hat," Bob said. "But every year, the bike would end up going to a family who had experienced some kind of loss."

Norbert wasn't wealthy and was kept busy running his business and caring for 11 children, but he still did what he could for the neighbors and community he cared about. Bob feels compelled to do the same.

At 70 years old Bob retired after working for 55 years at Classic Products. He started as a shipping clerk and worked his way up through the company to become the Executive Vice President. "I worked hard and always put myself forward to take on new responsibilities. I was willing to learn and do anything."

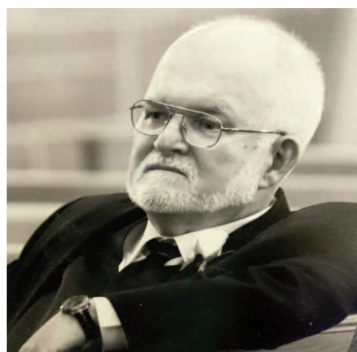
"Anything you do, you get back in spades. Don't be afraid, and just do it."

After a life of hard work, it was time for Bob to take it easy. But before long he was bored. That was when he visited volunteer.org and discovered Cancer Services of Northeast Indiana sought volunteer drivers.

"I drove a lot for work and was comfortable with driving. So it was a no brainer."

At 66 Bob was diagnosed with throat cancer. He intimately understood the struggles of a cancer diagnosis and the difficult treatments which followed.

From then on, he's provided free transportation for Cancer Services

clients to cancer treatments. On average, he generously donates 120 hours of his time each year to helping people with cancer get to their treatment.

During the trip, he always makes a point to share that he is a cancer survivor. "Some people don't want to talk much, and some people do. I just listen. I've met some incredible people with amazing life stories. I've enjoyed the history they gave me."

Bob also volunteers for Meals on Wheels and, during the Christmas season, he brings joy to area children as Santa Claus.

In his downtime, he enjoys relaxing at home with his two Rottweilers and reading books. Bob estimates that he read 200 books during COVID, when he couldn't spend his time volunteering.

If you'd like to volunteer as a driver but are feeling apprehensive, Bob has this to share: "Anything you do, you get back in spades. Giving the people I help someone to talk to makes me feel better about myself. The people you'll drive need help. Don't be afraid, and just do it."
